What is Kodiak?

Kodiak is a leadership course for venturing age youth and senior boy scouts 14 years and older. It is to be done over a six day period during which the youth are away from home not sleeping in the comfort of their own bed. This could take place at a summer camp, on a summer high adventure trek or over two long weekend campouts. The program takes about 1 to 1 1/2 hours per day and can be done any time during that day's activity. Kodiak participation is a new requirement for the Venturing silver award. This director's course will give you the tools and skills necessary to teach Kodiak to your crew or an advance leadership for you troop.
