

Course Location:

We will be holding the course at the LDS Church campground Zion's Camp in Belfair Washington. Coming from Tacoma across the Narrows Bridge these are the directions on how to get there (it is about a 1 hour drive from the bridge).

- Take Hwy 16, use the Bremerton exit. (Go over the Narrows Bridge.)
- Follow Hwy 16 past Port Orchard exits. Get into the left lane for Shelton-Belfair.
- Sign reads **HIGHWAY 3 SOUTH, SHELTON-BELFAIR**. Exit left at the stop light (Hwy 3).
- Follow Hwy 3 through Belfair (approx. 8-9 miles).
- At the signal, turn right toward Union (Hwy 106).
- Follow Hwy 106 approximately 4 miles.
- Turn left on E. Trails Road.
- Go up the hill approximately 2 miles.
- Turn left on Trails End Drive.
- Stay to the right on Trails End Drive. Go to Crest Drive.
- Turn right on Crest Drive.
- Continue on Crest Drive to Coon Drive.
- Take the right road (Coon Drive South) around the end of Coon Lake.
- Follow signs to end of road.

If you get lost and need additional instructions, the camp is run by LDS missionaries that can be reached at 360-275-6601. Do not use a GPS it will take some place out in the woods not to the camp.

- Clothing for overnight training event, some activities will be held outside.

Leadership Training

This is a two day course that will certify you to conduct a Kodiak and Kodiak X leadership training in your own crew.

Kodiak and Kodiak X are the 2nd and 3rd parts of the three part Nature of leadership series offered to venturing crews and older scouts.



A Kodiak course is unique in that it is offered as part of a high-adventure trek. Kodiak teaches leadership skills in a fun way that is internalized by the Venturers

who take the course. In other words, it is a challenging high-adventure trek with a simple and fun leadership course included. Kodiak is not taught indoors or in a classroom; it is done completely outdoors using nature's examples of leadership

Kodiak X is a weekend course that builds on the leadership skills learned in Kodiak. There are practical leadership exercises where youth are given opportunity to lead through a variety of scenarios.

Both of these courses are designed to be completely youth lead and youth taught. The CDC will teach you the proper way to conduct a course and methods of training youth instructors.
