## John Muir Trail Trek & Kodiak Youth Leadership Training Camp Oljato 2010

This Kodiak Trek (co-ed) combines a fun and challenging hike on the John Muir Trail with leadership sessions to help young people develop their leadership skills such as planning, team-building, and communication. The trek begins at Camp Oljato and ends at College Campground off of Huntington Lake Road. The John Muir Trail offers some of the most scenic vistas in California's Sierra range.



When: August 1 – August 7, 2010

Cost: \$275 includes transportation, meals, camping fees, group equipment, and t-shirt. Participants provide own personal camping equipment.

Reservation: A \$50 **non-refundable deposit** is required to hold your spot. The final payment is due on or before June 1st, 2010. **The Kodiak Trek requires a maximum of 8 participants! Register early!**

Requirements: *Annual Health and Medical Record form (parts A, B, and C) are required for all participants. All participants must be in good shape and be prepared to hike 10 miles per day in rugged terrain.*

*Required age for participants is 14 through 20; fourteen year olds must be graduated from Junior High. Participants must be registered with a Boy Scouts of America Venturing Crew or Ship.
